

IRS 990-N Report

Any Post that has income under \$25,000.00 has to file a 990-N (e-postcard) with the IRS. This is new this year. You file the report through the internet and the only information that you need is your federal Employer Identification Number (EIN), the Commander's name and address and the Quartermaster's name and address. It takes a very few minutes to do. Failure to file for three straight years will result in the Post losing its non-profit status.

Stimulation Check

Every citizen is entitled to receive at least a \$300 refund from the IRS regardless if you had to file a tax return or not. If you had to file a return you have probably already received your refund. Those of you that are retired and do not have to file a return have until October 15, 2008 to file for the Stimulation Check. Make sure you pass this information out in your monthly news letter and post it on your bulletin board.
